Saluran Tarum Barat or Kalimalang is the main support for the supply of clean water for settlements and industries from Karawang, Bekasi, to Jakarta. This is the basis for the need to maintain Kalimalang water quality. YRE is collaborating with the Coca-Cola Foundation Indonesia (CCFI) through the “Seeing, Sharing and Working for Kalimalang” or HATI Kalimalang program to encourage movement formation and collaboration with long-term action and monitoring. This collaborative movement is accompanied by pioneering actions to reduce water pollution and improve Kalimalang’s water quality in the long term.
